Old Business

1. David Jude completed the in-field portion of his water sampling on August 10, 2018. It was expected he will give us his report on 4-13-19(today). One of the limnologists he works with at University of Minnesota had a myocardial infarction, delaying his results. It is expected Dr. Jude will present his results at the May 11, 2019 meeting.
2. We had put in a request to the DEQ to allow us to do expanded algal treatments out to the 15' contour. This would be the first time the DEQ had allowed such a treatment. The permit was granted for Long Lake. It was denied for Palmer Lake because of an endangered species of fish in the fish sampling. The treatments could begin during the week of June 24. There could be up to 5 treatments at 2 week intervals. There would be no water use restrictions related to the treatments. The costs will be discussed at the May meeting. Progressive AE , PLM , and Dr. Jude should all be in attendance to take part in the discussion.
