Old Business

1. Discussion about Long Lake algal treatment. The DEQ initially did not approve an algal treatment on Long Lake for 2019 as we had assumed, they instead tabled it. This resulted in a delay in obtaining the permits required and required supplemental information be submitted. It was subsequently approved on 8/2/19 and treatments were begun that day. The plan is to do 3 treatments at 2 week intervals. Progressive AE will do water sampling after the final treatment and present results at the 9/28 meeting.
2. The terms for the Long and Palmer Riparian members of the Lakeboard will expire at the end of the year. New members will be appointed at the 9/28 meeting. An announcement was placed in the Sturgis Journal twice outlining the application process for those interested in serving on the Lake Board.

New Business

1. Advisory Committee, report accepted. Water clarity; Long Lake 5.0 ' , Palmer 2.0', Lepley Lake (none). Water Temperature 78 degrees. The composite lake survey will not likely occur until after any algal treatments have been completed.
2. Motion to solicit bids for applicators for the next 5 year cycle, Costello/Bell, all yes. RFPs will be solicited for an aquatic vegetation treatment applicator prior to next year's assessment renewal

3. Discussion of possible re-assessment of old veterinary office as it is no longer a commercial property. The property owner was not present and would need to make an appeal.
4. Scheduled remaining Lakeboard meetings for 2019; 9/28. All meetings will begin at 10:00 AM and be held at the Colon Township Hall, 132 N. Blackstone Ave
